In the context of the Jubilee Year of Mercy which begins December 8, 2015, Pope Francis has made recent remarks concerning absolution from the sin of abortion. By authorizing all priests throughout the world, Pope Francis is reminding everyone of the grave nature of the sin of abortion, while underscoring the importance of the sacrament of Reconciliation through which a person with a contrite and repentant heart may encounter the rich mercy of the Lord Jesus Christ. Since 1983, priests in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown have been authorized to absolve from the sin of abortion, which means there is no need to wait for the Jubilee Year of Mercy. Anyone who is burdened by or has questions about the sin of abortion or other serious matters is encouraged to seek the help of any priest in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown. The times for the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation are readily available at every parish.
